

Made Safe Job Posting: Safety Trainer

Purpose, Duties and Responsibilities, and Working Conditions

Job Purpose: To deliver Made Safe's safety and health training to manufacturing organizations across Manitoba. Job also includes creating new training content and revising current training content.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Working with the SkillsPass learning management system to publish the training schedule.
- Revision of current training content for formatting, branding, and content.
- Manage training supply inventories.
- Manage Train the Trainer materials and ensure members receive the appropriate materials in a timely fashion.
- Provide day-to-day support for training sessions (both in-person and online training).
- Support the document control system, training, and resource libraries.
- Involvement with the Safe Work Manitoba Endorsed Training process.
- Delivery of safety and health training:
 - o at Made Safe's Winnipeg location and across Manitoba
 - o in-person and via online webinars and hybrid sessions
- Includes all tasks involved in preparing for a training session, delivering the training session, and completing all required post-training session tasks
- Other duties as assigned.

Work Environment:

- Usually in an office or training room environment
- Sometimes on a manufacturing shop floor or outside, in hot or cold conditions

Physical Demands:

- Able to lift containers of training material (binders, manuals, etc., approx. 7 to 10 kg)
- Able to deliver in-person on-your-feet training for a full day, multiple days in a row

Requirements:

- Valid Class 5 vehicle driver's license
- Reliable vehicle

Travel: Single-day and multiple-day travel across Manitoba required



Position Type: Full-time, permanent

Hours of Work: Monday to Friday, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm is the default workweek, but schedule flexibility is required, including starting and/or finishing a workday earlier or later per training and travel requirements.

Vacation: 3 weeks per year
